Louisiana School for the Deaf Fund Descriptions

General Non-Restricted Fund

<u>Unrestricted Fund (00)</u> – funds are used to benefit the general school population. These funds are unrestricted.

Restricted Funds

Scholarship Fund (02) – funds are distributed to students to defray the cost of post-secondary educational and training expenses.

<u>Athletic Fund (03)</u> – funds are used to support students and coaches participating in organized athletics and to acquire resources unavailable through other sources.

<u>Cheerleader Fund (95)</u> - funds are used to support cheerleaders and coaches participating in organized athletics and to acquire resources unavailable through other sources.

Needy Student Fund (05) – funds are used to assist students with personal items, services, recreational items, and student activities which parents are unable to afford.

<u>Library Fund (13)</u> - funds are used to purchase books and other resources unavailable through other sources.

<u>Home Management Fund (16)</u> – funds are utilized by the Home Management Program for an independent living practicum for students residing in apartments or independent living areas in the High School Dorm and Special Needs Dorm.

<u>Preparatory/Elementary Fund (17)</u> - funds are used to acquire resources for the Preparatory/Elementary Department that would not be available through other sources. Items include but are not limited to replacement of lost or damaged library books and textbooks, as well as the support of behavior management systems within the school which assist the students in developing and maintaining appropriate behavior.

<u>Jr NAD Fund (National Association of the Deaf) (21)</u> – funds are used to provide financial support for selective members and sponsors who attend the annual JR NAD conventions and local workshops to enhance social leadership skills.

<u>Yearbook Fund (29)</u> – funds provide financial support for the cost of producing the annual student yearbook.

<u>Talbot Scholarship Fund (35)</u> – funds invested in scholarship fund. Interest earnings on principal are used for the purpose of awarding scholarships.

<u>Dormitory Program Fund (50)</u> – funds support student oriented activities, the Miss LA School for the Deaf Pageant, miscellaneous expenditures for the dormitories and employee training/travel, and to support employment of students to earn spending money.

<u>High School Fund (56)</u> – funds are used to assist the High School Department in acquiring items unavailable through other sources, to support the costs of personal vocational projects as part of class/learning projects, and to support behavior management systems established at LSD to assist in developing and maintaining appropriate behavior.

<u>Middle School Fund (69)</u> – funds are used to assist the Middle School Department in acquiring items unavailable through other sources, to support the costs of personal vocational projects as part of class/learning projects, and to support behavior management systems established at LSD to assist in developing and maintaining appropriate behavior.

Academic Bowl Fund (65) – funds provide support for academic bowl activities.

<u>Drama Club Fund (89)</u> –funds are used for the purchase of materials and activities for play productions, club advertising and maintenance materials, club t-shirts, and items for fundraising sales.

<u>Jr. Quota Club (92)</u> – funds support the club in order to purchase supplies/materials for their service projects, club t-shirts, etc.

<u>Faculty Fund (94)</u> – funds are used to purchase appreciation items for faculty and staff, as well as refreshments for faculty meetings.

<u>Class of 2016 Fund (96)</u> – funds support senior class activities including prom, graduation/senior week activities, appreciation gifts, senior class trip, parties, etc.

<u>Class of 2017 Fund (97)</u> – funds support senior class activities including prom, graduation/senior week activities, appreciation gifts, senior class trip, parties, etc.

<u>Class of 2018 Fund (98)</u> – funds support senior class activities including prom, graduation/senior week activities, appreciation gifts, senior class trip, parties, etc.

<u>Class of 2019 Fund (99)</u> – funds support senior class activities including prom, graduation/senior week activities, appreciation gifts, senior class trip, parties, etc.
