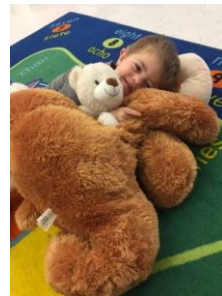
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## Bimodal Bilingual Program

Pre-K students at LSD are enrolled in classrooms with certified teachers focusing on both signed and spoken language development through daily instruction.

Students are provided with opportunities to sign, listen, and talk in a variety of communicative contexts, as well as participate in activities designed to improve overall language development.

Students also have dedicated speech instruction with certified speech language pathologists, as well as opportunities to practice their signing skills with adult language role models and peers.

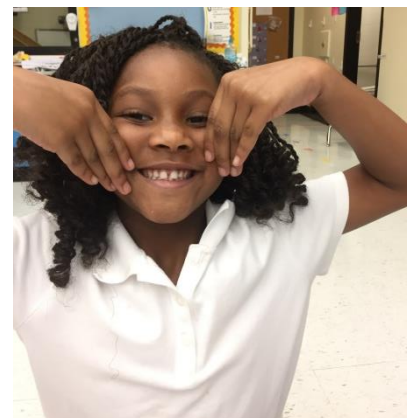


## Amplification

Students may wear their amplification during all waking hours at school and are encouraged to do so during speech and language development activities.

Students' hearing technology is tested using the LING & sound test to ensure proper functioning.

An on-site audiologist is available to troubleshoot hearing technology and offer support.
